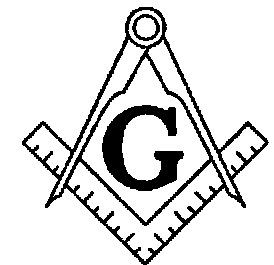

Trestle Board Message from the East

Weather permitting; let's plan to hold our regular meetings on April 14 and 28 in Nevadaville. Since we won't have water, dinners will be of a light nature such as cold cut sandwiches. For April 14, let's have a work party at 4:00 PM to reopen the building, dust off the furniture, etc. Lodge will open at 6:30 PM.

It's with sadness that we begin March with the passing of Brother William (Bill) G. Weaver who died Feb. 24, 2007, at the age of 92. When Bill joined Nevada 4, he told me the story:

He and his father, Forest G. Weaver, were driving around the Central City area one weekend in 1948. They happened through Nevadaville and saw the boarded up Masonic Lodge. Bill's dad, a Mason and author of "Poems Masonic and Others" (published in 1926), was saddened to see the closed up building. Bill didn't think too much of the incident until some 50 years later when he was helping some friends who had a house in Russell Gulch. Bill returned to Nevadaville and saw that the lodge was again meeting in its 1879 building. That's when Bill decided it was time to become a Mason. On October 24, 1998 Bill received the Entered Apprentice degree and on June 5, 1999 at the Ghost Town Communication, Bill was raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason.

Perhaps Bro. Bill had one of his father's poems in mind when he joined the lodge. The poem was printed in the Memorial Service Bulletin by his family.

A Mason's Prayer

"Thou, O God, who do'est all things well, Guide true, my footsteps in this vale of tears, Teach me each day to try to parallel The two Saints John, those early Christian peers.
